# Erosion Control & Stormwater Program Updates

### **Trans 401 Rulemaking**

- Scope statement <u>SS 002-24 (wisconsin.gov)</u>
- Purpose
  - Modifications and updates to bring the rule into conformance with NR 151, NR 216 and other relevant rules and standards.
  - Incorporate procedures and requirements that changed with issuance of the TCGP and TS4 permits.
  - Goal: consistency and clarity





### Trans 401 Rulemaking – Timeline

- Summer/fall 2024 stakeholder kick off meetings
- Sep. 2024 to May 2025 stakeholder engagement meetings and rule drafting
- June & July 2025 rule drafting, stakeholder review, final drafting
- Aug. 2025 WisDOT leadership review
- Sep. 2025 draft rule submitted to legislature for legislative review process
- July 8, 2026 scope statement expires





### **Trans 401 Rulemaking**

- Anticipated changes:
  - Editorial updating links and references; electronic submittals
  - Reorganization and structural changes
  - Incorporating and updating to ensure conformance with NR 151 and 216 updates, as well as TCGP and TS4 permits

TRANSPORTATION CONSTRUCTION GENERAL PERMIT.



















# Endangered Species Updates



### **Endangered Species in Construction**

- Pay attention to special provisions.
- Working to improve consistency and clarity of environmental special provisions.
- Common examples:
  - Migratory birds
  - In-stream work restrictions
  - Seasonal timing restrictions





# **Bat Updates**

#### **Tri-colored Bat (TCB)**

- In Sep. 2022, FWS proposed to list the tricolored bat as endangered.
  - Effective date TBD
- Similar avoidance and minimization measures as NLEB.
- WisDOT actively preparing for the anticipated listing.



















## Bat Updates (con't)

#### Tri-colored bat range map (FWS)




















#### Mussels

  - Critical habitat
- Proposed critical habitat for:
  - Sheepnose
  - Snuffbox
  - Spectaclecase




















#### **Rusty Patched Bumble Bee Critical Habitat**

 Proposed rule to designate critical habitat for RPBB






















### **Monarch Butterfly**

 Proposed rule to list the Monarch Butterfly as threatened with a 4(d) rule























# Hazardous Materials Program Reminders

### **Mandatory Disposal Contracts**

- Mandatory disposal contracts for:
  - Lamps, ballast, bulbs
  - Mercury containing switches
  - Hazardous waste
  - Tank sludge from underground or above ground petroleum storage tanks
  - Bridge paint waste

- Contractor Responsibility:
  - Construction & demolition waste
  - Solid waste (nonrecyclable) paper, glass, metal, other debris)
- Guidance on WisDOT's website



















- Purpose: protect fish and aquatic resources during sensitive periods in their life cycles (spawning, egg hatching and young fish)
- Windows set by DNR fisheries biologists







- Timing Restrictions
  - September 15 to June 15 all Great Lakes tributaries upstream to first barrier
  - September 15 to May 15 all trout streams
  - March 1 to June 15 for all other waters
- Variability due to:
  - Type of aquatic species present
  - Life cycle needs















- Is there flexibility with the windows?
  - Typically limited to unique situations
  - Requests for flexibility shouldn't be common practice
- Process
  - Contractor submits request to WisDOT, explaining need
  - WisDOT staff will consult with DNR liaison and fisheries biologists


