 - reinforces the need to thoroughly ecope projects
 - provides feedback to improve future plan design
 - ensures accurate plans for bid lettings.
- The results help improve future design processes and guidance and should ultimately reduce project costs.






































































































Process improvements ARIPWeb

Agricultural Roads Improvement Progra

- SEG-funded grant appropriation in the 2023-25 biennium.
- Nearly \$50 million awarded in first round
- Another \$100 million to be awarded later this month

New resource

- ARIPWeb online portal is similar to the existing LRIPWeb online porta
- Local sponsors required to provide the advertising information seven days prior to publishing
- WisDOT will review and export available advertising information on a weekly basis
- A list of all advertising information will subsequently be made available online


